1. Blue bins should only be used for recycling plastic bottles and jugs; glass bottles and jars; aluminum and steel beverage food cans. **Yes No**
2. Paper products, including cardboard should be placed in the green recycling bin. **Yes No**
3. All food contaminants should be rinsed from cans, bottles, jars and jugs. **Yes No**
4. All caps should be removed and disposed of as trash. **Yes No**
5. Bottles, jars and cans should be separated and placed in plastic or paper bags. **Yes No**
6. The only plastics accepted are #1 and #2 bottles and jugs. **Yes No**
7. Broken glass cannot be accepted. It is hazardous, and dangerous to collectors. **Yes No**
8. It is okay to place dirty and soiled paper products in the green bin. **Yes No**
9. Cardboard boxes should be flattened and contained inside or adjacent to the green bin, in larger boxes, or tied in bundles. **Yes No**
10. It's okay to place waxed paper products in the green bin. **Yes No**
11. Shredded paper must be bagged (in paper or plastic bags), to prevent blowing and spreading of material. **Yes No**
12. "Non-recyclables" are left behind for the resident to dispose of as trash. **Yes No**
