



LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION
March 23, 2010

The Local Liquor Control Commission held a meeting on Tuesday, March 23, 2010, in City Council Chambers, Room 108 of the Civic Center, 200 S. Illinois Avenue. Chairman Brad Cole called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the following-named members of the Commission present/absent:

2. Approval of Minutes

3. Consideration of Applications for two Class F1 Liquor Licenses for Carbondale Main Street Downtown Art and Wine Fairs on May 22, 2010, and October 2, 2010

The City Clerk noted that Carbondale Main Street was applying for temporary liquor licenses for two Downtown Art and Wine Fairs, the first on Saturday, May 22, 2010, with a rain date of Sunday, May 23, and the second on Saturday, October 2, 2010, with a rain date of Sunday, October 3, 2010. Times for the Fairs will be 3:00 to 9:00 p.m.. The Liquor Advisory Board reviewed these applications on March 9th and recommended approval contingent upon outstanding items. The only outstanding item is proof of insurance.

Carbondale Main Street Director Meghan Cole was present to answer questions. In response to Commissioner Pohlmann's inquiry, Ms. Cole said there will be no conflict with the Saturday morning Farmer's Market.
