



**LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION**  
**May 18, 2010**

The Local Liquor Control Commission held a meeting on Tuesday, May 18, 2010, in City Council Chambers, Room 108 of the Civic Center, 200 S. Illinois Avenue. Chairman Brad Cole called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the following-named members of the Commission present/absent:

**3. Consideration of an Application for a Class B2 liquor license for PPPCD, Inc., d/b/a Pinch Penny Pub, 700 East Grand Avenue**
